About us & the role

We have embarked on an ambitious journey to engage with the most vulnerable communities in our society. Part of this will be the continuation of SPACE which FfB and Project 229 have been running in partnership with Bedford Borough Council. As well as working closely with local schools, SPACE provides young people fortnightly access to a youth provision and holiday clubs specifically for children and young people affected by domestic abuse. The offices of Project 229 and the youth clubs are based in Kempston. As a SPACE Sessional Youth Worker you will play a pivotal role in securing the best outcomes for children and young people at evening youth groups and holiday clubs.

What we are looking for

You will have experience of working with children in a similar role, be an excellent communicator, and have a good understanding of the impact of adverse childhood experiences on children and young people. You will be able to work flexible hours when required, including evenings (on average once a fortnight) and school holidays. Male youth workers are encouraged to apply but females with appropriate experience are also desirable for this role. What is more important is that you can engage positively with children and young people and are able to make relationship-building central to your work.

You will be well supported by the lead SPACE Youth Worker who will provide supervisions and oversight and we will provide a safe and secure environment for you to work in. More importantly, we can offer you the opportunity to work with a group of like-minded professionals committed to improving the lives of children and young people affected by domestic abuse.
